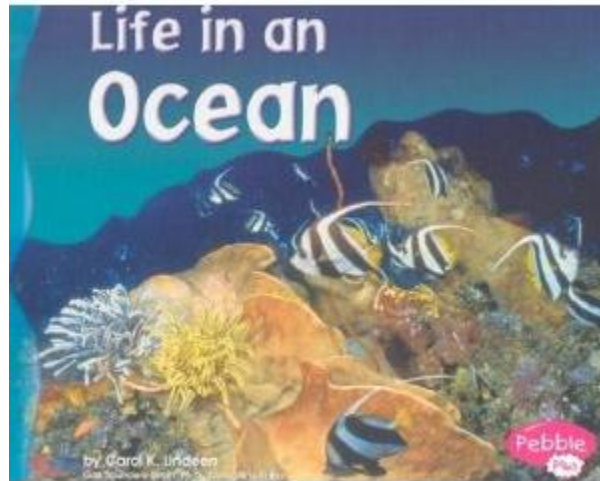

Amazing (Vocabulary) Words: *ocean, crab, fish, world, shell, seaweed*

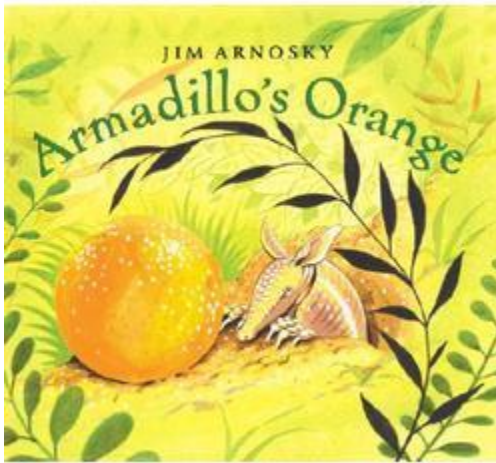

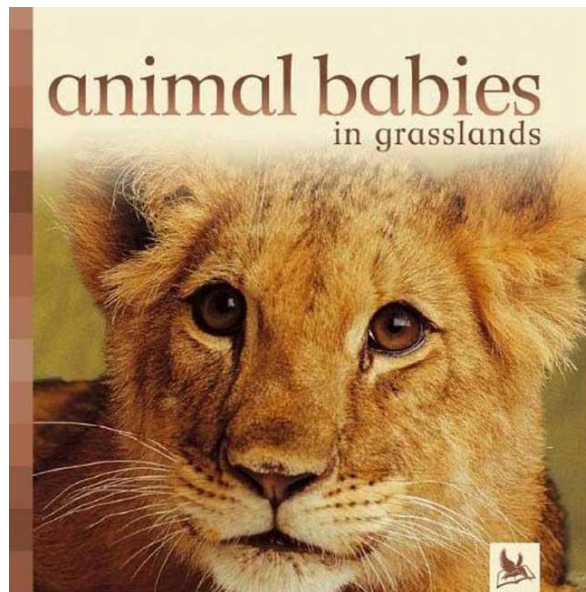

Amazing (Vocabulary) Words: *calf, cub, joey, grassland, pup, foal*

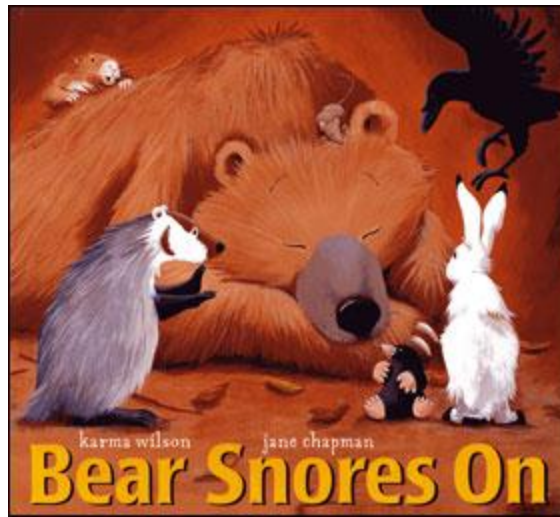

Amazing (Vocabulary) Words: *sleep, cave, storm, winter, woods, blustery*

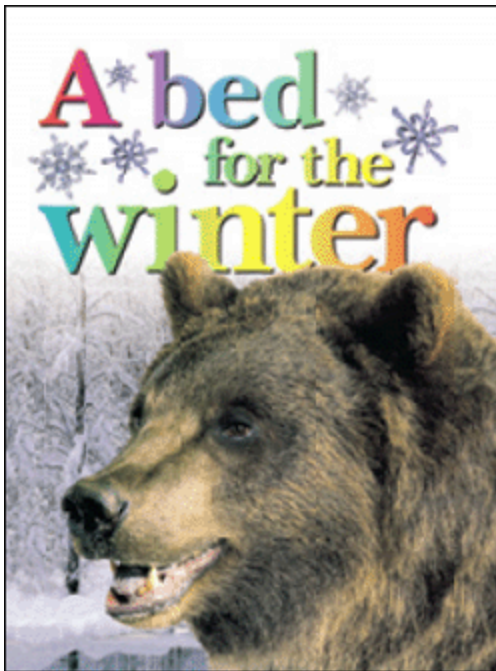

Amazing (Vocabulary) Words: *meadow, stump, hive, nest, tree trunk, den*

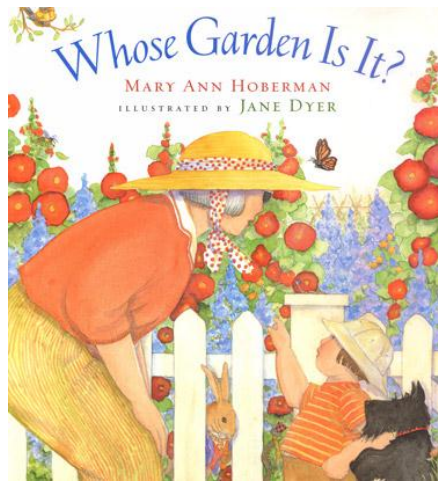
